Hot Tip #1

Read the directions.

Know how your equipment operates.

Hot Tip #2

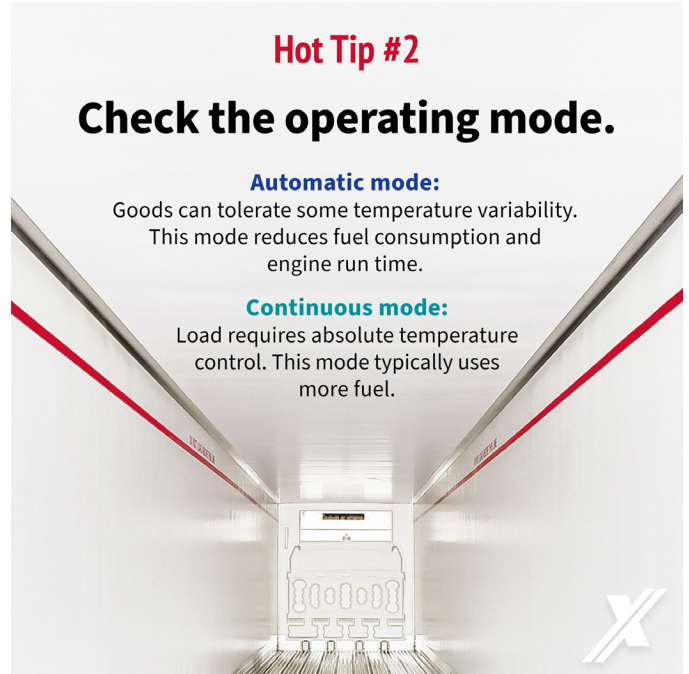
Check the operating mode.

Automatic mode:

Goods can tolerate some temperature variability.
This mode reduces fuel consumption and
engine run time.

Continuous mode:

Load requires absolute temperature
control. This mode typically uses
more fuel.

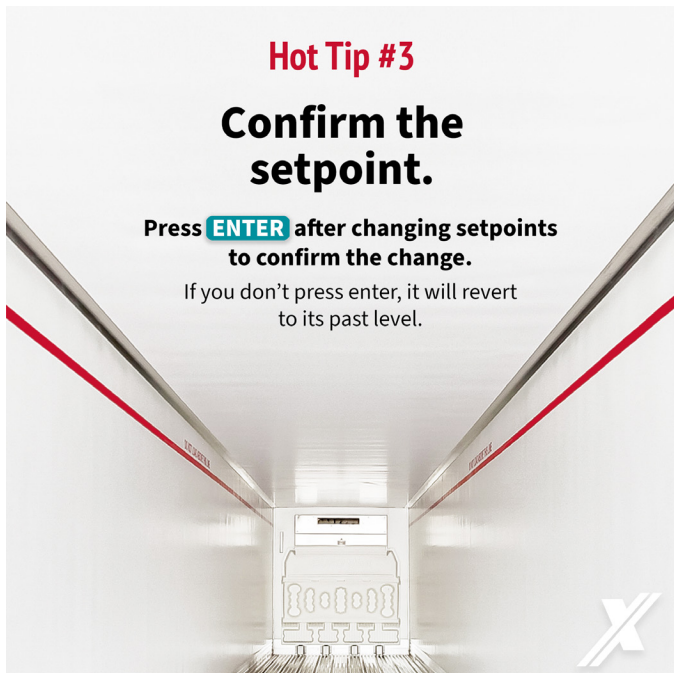


Hot Tip #3

Confirm the setpoint.

Press **ENTER** after changing setpoints
to confirm the change.

If you don't press enter, it will revert
to its past level.



Hot Tip #4

Fill 'er up.

Check the refrigeration unit's fuel level
before hitting the road. A reefer unit
engine can lose its prime if air is drawn
into the system—which results in a
service call to purge the system
and restart the engine.
